VIPERS is an acronym to aid the recall of the 6 reading domains as part of the UK's reading curriculum. The use of VIPERS ensures that teachers ask, and pupils are familiar with, a range of key comprehension questions.

Pupils will be made familiar with these different aspects of comprehension so that they can use the different comprehension skills when reading a text.
